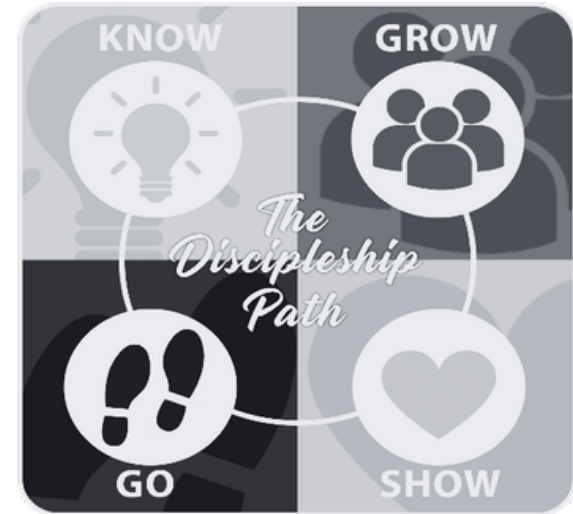
EXPLORE THE BIBLE
